### CHattel MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 10th day of April 1915, by and between  
Ethan Allen and Maggie Allen, his wife  
of the County of Bingham and State of Idaho, part ies of the first part, and D. W. Standrod & Company, Bankers-  
of the County of Bingham and State of Idaho, the part y of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said part ies of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred fifty and no/100- (\$150.00) DOLLARS  
to them in hand paid by the said part y of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
ha ve granted, bargained, sold and assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and assign, transfer and set over, unto the said part y of the second part, all those certain goods  
and chattels situated in Bingham County, State of Idaho, and particularly described as follows:

- One Black mare age 3 years, weighing 1100 pounds and branded (K) on left thigh;
- One black gelding age 3 years, weighing 1100 pounds and branded (K) on left thigh;
- One black mare age 6 years, weighing 1200 pounds and branded (K) on left shoulder;
- One black gelding age 6 years, weighing 1100 pounds and branded R on jaw;

to have and to hold, all and singular, the goods and chattels above bargained and sold, or intended to be unto the said  
part y of the second part its /successors executors, administrators or assigns forever and the said part  
ies of the first part expressly covenant and warrant:

1. That they are the absolute and exclusive owners of said chattels and that the same  
are free from all liens and incumbrances.
2. That they will properly attend and care for said mortgaged property at all times.
3. That they will promptly pay all taxes on said chattels and will retain the same in their  
own possession except as to said second part y and will not suffer the same to be encumbered, sold  
or removed from said Bingham County without the written consent of said second part y.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of One certain promissory  
note executed and delivered by said first part ies to the said part y of the second part, of which  
the following is a copy:

in U. S. gold coin, payable at the BANKING HOUSE of <u>D. W. STANDROD &amp; CO., Blackfoot, Idaho,</u> with interest at <u>ten</u> per centum per <u>annus</u> from date until paid. Interest payable quarterly from date.	
If the interest be not paid as stipulated, the legal holder of this note may declare the principal due, and proceed by law to recover both principal and interest. And we do hereby agree, that in case this note is collected by an attorney, with or without suit, to pay a reasonable attorney's fee.
