Bruce R McConkie:

Personage of Spirit

- D&C 130:22
 - "the Holy Ghost has not a body of flesh and bones, but is a personage of Spirit. Were it not so, the Holy Ghost could not dwell in us."
- Joseph F Smith:
 - "the Holy Ghost is a personage of spirit, he constitutes the third person in the Trinity, the Godhead. The gift or presentation of the Holy Ghost is the authoritative act of conferring him upon man." (Gospel Doctrine, Pg 61)

Light of Christ different from the Holy Ghost

Joseph Fielding Smith:

"The Holy Ghost should not be confused with the Spirit which fills the immensity of space and which is everywhere present. This other Spirit is impersonal and has no size, nor dimension; it proceeds forth from the presence of the Father and the Son and is in all things. We should speak of the Holy Ghost as a personage as "he" and this other Spirit as "it," although when we speak of the power or gift of the Holy Ghost we may properly say "it." " (Doctrines of Salvation, 1:49-50)

Joseph Fielding Smith:

"I know that frequently the Holy Ghost and the Spirit of Christ have become confused. There are passages that have to be judged solely by the context, but it seems to me that the Lord has made very clear the difference between the mission of each. One is a Personage of Spirit and the third member in the Godhead. The other is a spirit of light and truth which fills the immensity of space and gives light to the intelligence of men, whether they believe in Christ or not." (Answers to Gospel Questions, 5:137)

Quotes:

Elder Bradford said many people do not really comprehend what it means to "teach by the Spirit." He explained that when he was a missionary in Japan, he learned the Japanese have two different words for "light." One word, as used in dealing with rays of light, simply means the absence of darkness.

The other word means enlightenment—the clarity and understanding that come into the mind about a concept or particular truth. "It is this light that we are talking about when we talk about teaching by the Spirit," explained Elder Bradford.

To illustrate how the light of the Spirit can enter into teaching and learning situations, he used the example of a computer. When all its parts are functioning properly, an operator can use an access code and, by obeying the "laws" that govern its use, extract information from it.

"In mortality, the Holy Ghost stands as a mediator to see that those who are obedient to the law may receive full access, as far as it is expedient, to the Lord's work," said Elder Bradford. "The Spirit that comes into the mind is a communicative system that teaches concepts of truth.

The Holy Ghost also stands as a guardian of sorts to see that the light of the Spirit cannot be accessed by those who are not fully obedient to the principles of the law."

Elder Bradford further said, "This light of the Spirit is divine. You cannot force the Spirit. The light of the Spirit will come to each person independently, upon divine principles, and those principles are outlined very clearly for us in the scriptures." Brigham Young:

"While sick, and asleep, about noon-day of the 17th inst., I dreamed that I went to see Joseph. He looked perfectly natural, sitting with his feet on the lower round of his chair. I took hold of his right hand and kissed it many times, and said to him, 'Why is it that we cannot be together as we used to be? You have been away from us a long time, and we want your society, and I do not like to be separated from you.'

"Joseph, rising from his chair and looking at me with his usual earnest, expressive and pleasing countenance, said, 'It is all right.' "I replied, 'I do not like to be away from you.'

"Joseph said, 'It is all right; we cannot be together yet; we shall be, by-and-by; but you will have to do without me awhile, and then we shall be together again.'

"I then discovered there was a hand right between us. Joseph stood by a window, and to the southwest of him it was very light. I was in the twilight, and to the north of me it was very dark. I said, 'Brother Joseph, the brethren, you know them well, better than I do, you raised them up, and brought the Priesthood to us, the brethren have a great anxiety to understand the law of adoption, or the sealing principles; and if you have a word of counsel for me, I should be glad to receive it.'

"Joseph stepped toward me, and, looking very earnestly, yet pleasantly, said, 'Tell the people to be humble and faithful, and be sure to keep the Spirit of the Lord, and it will lead them right. Be careful and not turn away the small, still voice; it will teach what to do and where to go; it will yield the fruits of the kingdom. Tell the brethren to keep their hearts open to convictions, so that when the Holy Ghost comes to them, their hearts will be ready to receive

it. They can tell the Spirit of the Lord from all other spirits; it will whisper peace and joy to their souls; it will take malice, strife and hatred, and all evil, from their hearts; and their whole desire will be to do good, bring forth righteousness, and build up the kingdom of God. Tell the brethren if they will follow the Spirit of the Lord, they will go right. Be sure to tell the people to keep the Spirit of the Lord; and if they will, they will find themselves just as they were organized by our Father in heaven, before they came into the world. Our Father in heaven organized the human family, but they are all disorganized and in great confusion.'

"Joseph then showed me the pattern, how they were in the beginning. This I cannot describe, but I saw it, and saw where the Priesthood had been taken from the earth, and how it must be joined together, so that there would be a perfect chain from Father Adam to his latest posterity. Joseph again said, 'Tell the people to be sure to keep the Spirit of the Lord, and follow it, and it will lead them just right."
