

Letter to Margrethe 1933:

Oslo 14 Dec – 33

Dear Sister

Well, we are getting close to Christmas again and a new year is coming. I praise God for being faithful this pass year and even more that I am in good health. It is great grace from him who controls everything with his almighty hand. I greet you from everyone here that we are all healthy and doing fine. It is not so much to do in the business nowadays but I cannot complain as long as it does not get worse. Unemployment is high. But I hope that if things don not get worse I get to keep the ones assisting me. One does not know anything it is so uneasy throughout the world (turn page) It all indicates that the household of this time is passed soon. And Jesus will come and get his expensive bride. We have a great preacher, Frank Mangs, who gathers thousands where he is and the best is that many are being saved. By the way there is a revival spirit throughout the nation of Norway. Praise the Lord and the Lamb.

I wonder how you are doing Maggi I hope you are well ad have what you need to live. We are not young anymore and furthermore you have become a widow. I hope the boys are helping you. But the best of it all is to be saved and have everything settled with God and be ready when he calls us to the home he has prepared. Yes, Maggie soon we will be home with Jesus who we have (turn page) prayed to and had communion with but then we will see him that our sole loves. Almost thought I would take a trip to Chicago and see the exhibition this summer but it is so expensive and furthermore it is so hot by you at that time of year. If so I wonder if it would be possible to visit you. Do you live far from Chicago?
